YMCA England and Wales-Working Safely During COVID-19

At YMCA England & Wales we understand our responsibility to ensure that our workplaces and activities are safe for everyone.

We have reviewed all of our practices through a risk assessment process, in line with Government Guidance Working Safely during Covid-19, to manage the risks of spread of Covid-19, to protect our Store Teams, Customers, Contractors and Visitors.

Take a look at our Staying Covid-19 Secure in 2020 notice. This confirms that we have complied with the Government's guidance on managing the risk of Covid-19, and have implemented the recommended 'Five steps to safer working together' approach:

- 1. We have carried out a Specific Covid-19 risk assessment and shared the findings with our Staff and Volunteers.
- 2. We have cleaning, handwashing and hygiene procedures in line with current guidance.
- 3. We have taken all reasonable steps to help people work from home.
- 4. We have taken all reasonable steps to maintain a 2 metre distance in the workplace.
- 5. Where people cannot be 2 metres apart, we have done everything practical to manage any possible transmission risk
